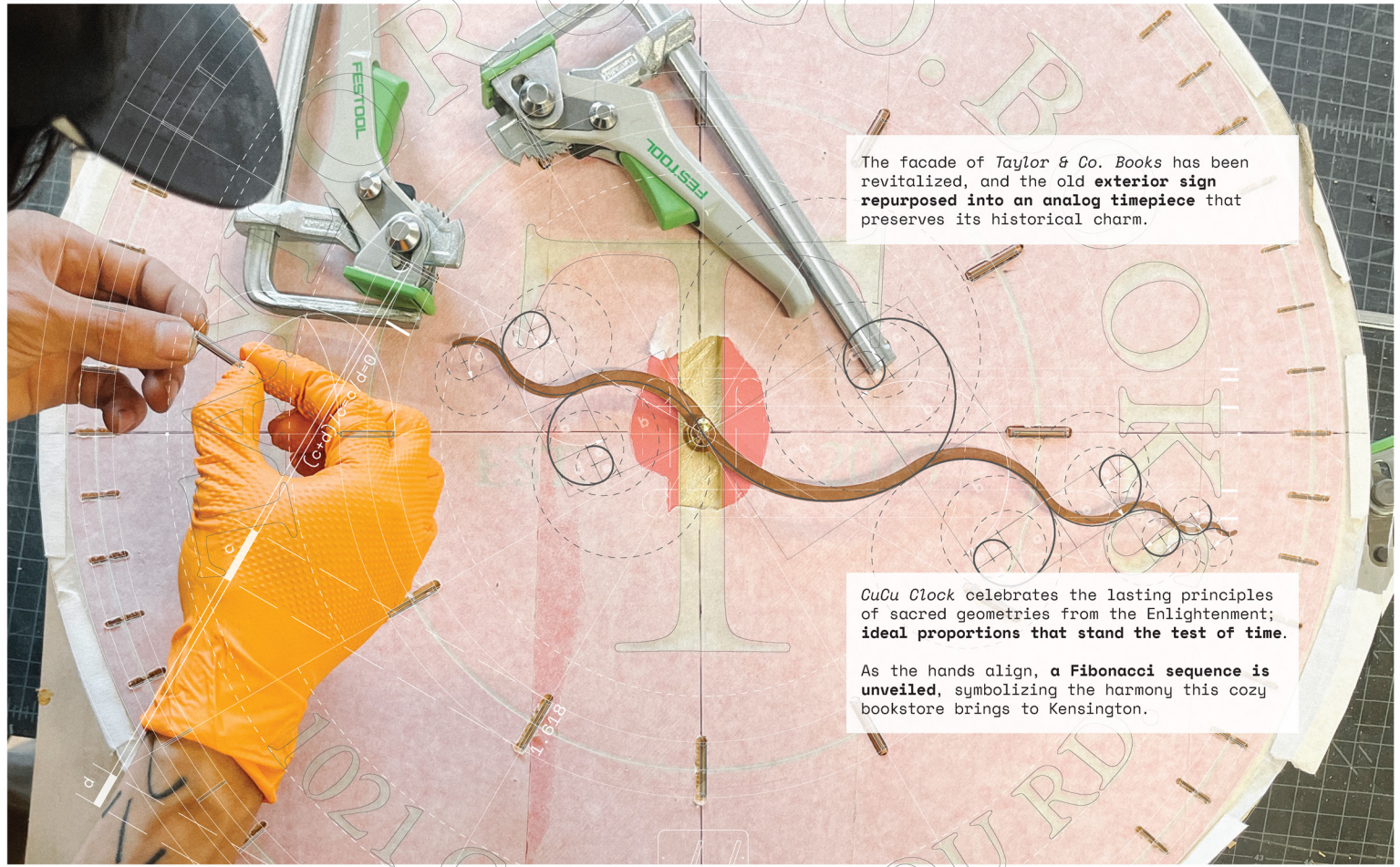

Selecting the right materials and fabrication techniques was integral to this piece. Copper character over time, featuring warm, metallic tones and a distinctive patina as it's exposed to its surroundings. Precise milling and mapping were required for inlaying intricate clock components. These tasks were accomplished using various machines from ILL, including the Shaper Origin CNC and WAZER water jet cutter. This meticulous attention to detail creates a timeless artifact that seamlessly blends art and engineering.



The facade of Taylor & Co. Books has been revitalized, and the old exterior sign repurposed into an analog timepiece that preserves its historical charm.
